

Earlier this year I was introduced to Luxaflex.



Having been in NZ since the 1950s, and with an extensive range of shades and blinds, I knew they were the right fit for our project.

As a first port of call, I found the Luxaflex website to be really comprehensive and easy to navigate. The content delves deep into the functionality of the blinds, so that you can gain a sound understanding/overview of the products, while quality imagery provides a great visual reference and further inspiration.

It really helped to narrow down the selection process based on my own personal needs and wants, before carrying out the next steps. The option of being able to order samples from the website is also a great added feature.



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
In-store

Visiting the Luxaflex showroom was the next step in the process. From a tactile point of view I always love being able to see and touch products. What's more, you can see how the blinds work once installed. I was now looking at blinds in a completely different way.

Rather than wanting them to disappear into the background, I was excited that they would be enhancing the look of our space, while making a huge difference to our quality of living by addressing our key issues of lack of privacy and too much light.

O4 Book a consultation

Luxaflex offer both in-store and in-home consultations which can be booked via the online tool. I decided to use the in-home consultation service and this proved invaluable. I could show the consultant our space as well as talk through how the light changes throughout the day. Discussing each of my shortlisted products, I was able to gain further clarification on the different features and aesthetic of each.









<u>os</u>Selections

Luxaflex have an extensive range of fabrics that differ depending on the type of blind you choose. The Sunscreens & Roller Blinds come in blockouts (ideal for bedrooms) and a huge range of materials. **The Silverscreen** – a Sunscreen featuring a Silverscreen metal-backed screen fabric – not only provides excellent vision out, it dramatically reduces heat and glare at the window, independent of screen colour. The high-end **Duette Architella** and **Silhouettes** come in a range of sheer fabrics, both of which really appealed.

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When it comes to colours, the choice is also vast. Wanting to stay within the realm of our neutral colour palette, I was spoilt for choice when it came to soft grey and beige tones. With a beautiful selection of samples in hand, I was able to take them home to see how they looked in our space, including how the fabrics and colours worked throughout different times of the day and night.

Having had issues with curtain cords in the past, I was thrilled to learn about the **PowerView Automation**. A completely cordless battery operated system, it can be installed without the need for an electrician, with the wireless technology allowing you to operate the blinds (from the couch!) with a smartphone app or the beautiful pebble shaped remote control.

With a final decision made on the blinds and colour – we chose the translucent *Silhouette blinds in Bicycle Beige* – Luxaflex made another home visit to measure up our windows. This is because all blinds are custom-made to order.
